IRS Tax Forms

All international students who studied in the US in 2016 are required to file a tax form in the United States. You are required to file this form even if you have no taxable income. The deadline to file if you have no income is June 15. The deadline to file if you have income from any source other than bank interest (like an on-campus job), is April 15. A: Semicolons are used to connect two related independent clauses in the same place where a period could go. You should not use it to separate an independent and dependent clause. Here are some examples.

- I thought it would be very cold in January; however, it wasn't cold.
- Incorrect: If the weather gets cold; I will have to wear a coat.
