

In the article "Found in translation: How 57 different languages have interpreted Charlotte Brontë's 'Jane Eyre'" by Matthew Reynolds (Scroll.in, Sep 30, 2019), by translation, people have come across a variety of works beyond the language boundaries. Thus, it is easy to think that translation is a perfect reproduction of an original text in other languages, but translation is a creation based on society and culture. This can be confirmed by Jane Eyre, which has been translated according to various languages and different periods. The title of Jane Eyre has changed depending on the language of translation, the country and the time of publication. This reflects the translator's view of the work. In the case of China, it was translated into a title that combines meaning with a play on words. In addition, subtle changes let readers feel fascinating changes in a work. When honorific titles and formality that exist differently by languages are projected into the translation process, the original text is expressed in slightly different "nuances" for each language. It is very unlikely that the same word will exist in another language, fully reflecting the different meanings that a word encompasses. Thus, translators sometimes replace the original word with slightly different words. It appears to lose its original meaning. But if interpreting the original word as a new word reflects the demands of the times or changes in society, the work may be to gain new vitality. Consequently, translation is a new literary creation based on society and culture.

What stood out most about Matthew Reynolds' writing was that he gave a good example of how translation can vary depending on the times and societies. In other words, just as language reflects society and ideology, it also makes it clear that translation that uses language also reflects the times and social situations. Through this point of view, I can think of the fact that translation is

both a reflection of a society and a cultural driving force that broadens the base of a society. The historical, cultural and socio-economic values of different languages transfer into other societies and diverse ideas in different societies. This diversity puts things in perspective and provides an opportunity for indirect experience to be objectively viewed in different situations or people. It was therefore thought that translation could have more significance in that it provided an opportunity for other ideas to be planted in one society.

However, the fact that translation is also a creation made me think about translator's subjective intervention. Matthew Reynolds talked about a new "gain" when literature was translated into various languages, but it occurred to me that in fact it could be a "loss" of the author's intention. The content or intention of the entire literary work will not be changed by the translator's small choice. But one small word may have been chosen carefully by the author. The idea of this intervention seems to ask both the translator and the reader how to treat the translation. My answer to this question is to communicate with the work in an active manner. First of all, the translator should spend plenty of time on the work before he or she translates it. And keep cool on areas that require subjective intervention. And I think it should be possible to evaluate objectively whether such intervention does not influence the impression of the whole work. Readers also need an appropriate attitude. The act of reading can be somewhat passive, but through writing, the author and reader communicate. Therefore, readers can also read actively. When I came to the U.S., in reading & writing class, where I have predicted and asked questions before reading, these small actions can change the way of reading. Therefore, I think it is important to be self-questioning about the world that the writer wants to talk about and understanding the work as a whole.

Finally, I hope that good works of different languages would be translated into different languages more often. A few years ago, "The Vegetarian", a work of a Korean artist, "Han Kang" won Man Booker International Prize. At that time, not only the author Han Kang, but also the translator Deborah Smith was also awarded. The news, for the first time, led me to think that language could also reflect the order of the world economy. Literary works that use the world's official language, such as English and French, are easily translated and widely read in other languages. But the opposite is very rare, such as a work written in a third world language being translated into English. Wouldn't the dominant status of English hinder the need to understand other languages in English? I hope that the various works that exist as much as the diversity of languages will be translated into different languages and that many people around the world will have access to.

Olga Tokarczuk, who won the 2018 Nobel prize in literature award, said she believes in the novel as a "deep way of communication across borders, across languages, across cultures."
