Dear scholarship students, we realize that you have had many challenges this semester, including the transition to Safeer2 for Saudi students and the transition to online classes for everyone. Almost all of you have financial guarantees that expire before August 7, 2020, which means that you will need to submit a new letter by the tuition deadline of May 20th for the Summer C semester to avoid owing a late fee. The US Census

Every 10 years the US Government counts all of the people living in the United States, including international students. This is called the US Census. You probably received the census form in the mail with instructions to complete it online. If you can, you should do this. If you do not complete the form online, US census workers might come to your apartment or home to ask you the questions in person.

Unfortunately, there are many scams that people use during the census. This

is what you should know to avoid scams:

--You will receive a physical letter through the US Mail from the "U.S. Census Bureau."

--You will NOT receive it via email. If you get an email saying it is the census, it is a scam.

--The census does not ask for social security or passport numbers

--The census does not ask for your bank account or credit card number --There is no cost to complete the census

--The census will not ask you for money or donations
