Notes from the Office

We want all of you to feel as comfortable as possible while you are studying with us here at the ELI. If you have any questions, your teachers, your Language Assistants, our staff members or administrators are here to help you! <u>May 19th</u>: As a student, you have many important documents to submit by Wednesday, May 19th.

- **Drop/Add Deadline, 4:30 p.m**. This is the last day to drop a class and get a refund. It is also the last day to add a class.
- Tuition Deadline, 1:30 p.m. Money orders, cashier's checks, or travelers' are acceptable. Credit or debit cards must be used online. No personal checks. No cash.
- Proof or health insurance
- Proof of immunizations

If you miss any of these deadlines, email Jennifer Vann ($\underline{ivann@eli.ufl.edu}$) or Victoria Dolce ($\underline{vcshelly@ufl.edu}$) right away, or you could be removed from classes or charged a late fee! Also, students who drop a class or withdraw from the ELI after the drop/add deadline on W, will not be able to receive a refund or credit for their courses and their transcript will have a grade of W (withdraw).

Attendance Policy

Class attendance is a requirement of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for students on the F-1 visa. It is also required by the ELI because you cannot learn English if you do not come to class regularly. For these reasons, the ELI has the following attendance policy:

- If you miss more than 25% of class, you can no longer attend ELI classes and your I-20 will be terminated.
- If you miss more than 15% of classes, or fail any of your classes, you will not receive a semester certificate and you will be allowed to return to the English Language Institute the next semester <u>ONLY</u> on a probationary basis.

If you miss five days in a row in all of your classes without informing the English Language Institute prior to or immediately after the five days, you can be expelled from the ELI.
