Notes from the Office

I20s: Make sure you have a printed, signed copy of your active I20 if you are leaving the US and returning. Also, check your I20 to make sure it isn't about to expire if you are returning next semester.

ELI Office Hours during the Break: The ELI main office will be open regular hours 12/13 - 12/17 and will be open from 9am - 3pm from 12/20 - 12/23. The main office will be closed from 12/24 - 12/31.

Returning Students: If you are returning to the ELI for the Spring 2022 semester, remember to check in online between January 3rd and January 7th.

Check your UF email: Please check your UF email for important messages before the end of the semester. Remember, if you are not returning to UF in January, you will lose access to your UF email and gatorlink at the end of the semester.

COVID Vaccination Requirement for Entry in the United States

A new CDC <u>Order</u> means that, in addition to showing a negative COVID-19 test, all nonimmigrant, non-citizen air travelers to the United States must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Travelers must provide proof of vaccination to get on an airplane to the United States. <u>The vaccine must be FDA or WHO approved</u>. The Order includes students on F-1 visas. All students will need to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination to enter the U.S. If you are leaving the United States during the winter break, you must bring your proof of vaccination with you. If you have not been vaccinated yet, we recommend you complete the vaccines before leaving the U.S. If you need help scheduling a vaccine or have questions about the new Order, you should talk to Victoria right away.
