Some organizations have worked to decrease the rate, but the country needs clear solutions. Teen pregnancy causes high levels of poverty, health problems, and teenagers can't study at the university. There are three proposed solutions to prevent teen pregnancy including sexual education, access at contraceptive methods, and after school activities.

Once parents and teachers know, they have to teach their children when they are young. If the teenagers know about their sexuality, they will make better decisions.

The second solution is giving contraceptive methods. When a teenager decides to have sexual relations, they will not stop. In Colombia, there is difficulty in accessing contraceptive methods because hospitals require teenagers to be accompanied by their parents. Hospitals should give contraceptive methods to every teenager when they need them. Hospitals shouldn't create barriers for teenagers have contraceptive methods, so hospitals should make medical appointments without parents. A teenager comfortable in her health center is a responsible teenager, and she can take steps to avoid pregnancy.

Finally, the Colombian government should offer after school activities to all students. Teenagers have much free time after school, and they need to spend time in productive activities. For example, teenagers who play sports think about their future, and they take care their bodies. When teenagers learn about different jobs, they begin to build their life project. They look for things that would like to do in their future. For this reason, it is important that teenagers can explore different activities because they are changing their lives. Also, after school activities drive teenagers to success, security, and happiness to long time.

In conclusion, Colombia needs to work in decreasing the rate of teen pregnancy because that increases the levels of poverty and decreases its development. Colombia can change the future of their teenagers with three easy solutions that promote the prevention of teen pregnancy. These solutions include education, access to contraceptive methods, and after school activities under an integral program with various faces, organizations, and people must help to decrease the rate of teen pregnancy.

The Independence Day



I attended *Fanfares and Fireworks Summer 2022* in Flavet field on July 3rd. It was so exciting because I have never seen the fireworks in site, and I really enjoyed it. The next evening, I watched *2022 Boston Pops July 4th Spectacular* which was performed in the Boston Common and live streamed on Bloomberg TV. Now, you can watch both of them on YouTube. These events gave me some interesting points, but I was not sure at first. So, after watching 2021 versions of them on YouTube, I convinced those points. The attitudes of audiences were much different from the US and Korea, and Gainesville and Boston.

The Fanfares and Fireworks were an awesome experience. My first impression was that the Independence Day of the US is a civil festival. Many families and groups of friends enjoyed the holiday freely and in their own ways, and congratulated their independence. And there were many people, adults as well as children, wearing national flag clothes and items in the Flavet field.

Although Korea also has an Independence Day which is August 15th, as far as I can remember, we have never had a festival like this. We have a formal ceremony where a president attends and addresses, but it is not the civil festival. Sometimes, we have outdoor concerts celebrating the day but we enjoy the concert itself, not our independence itself. We rarely have congratulating fireworks. Once we had the brilliant fireworks celebrating the 70th anniversary in 2015. Anyway, to most Koreans, the meaning of our Independence Day is just one of national holidays, not the civil festival. Furthermore, during the recent 5 years, the period of a reign of President Moon Jae-in, our government constantly blamed Japanese imperialism and demanded a formal apology about the brutalities in the past, rather than congratulate our independence. Because of political benefits, they made Koreans hate Japan, and basically, they deny the nation building of Republic of Korea. But present Japan is not imperial country any more. Actually, Japan and Korea are only democratic countries, except Taiwan, in Asia. Also, Japan is our ally forming Korea-US-Japan alliance which is geopolitically important for balance of power in Asia, which contribute the world peace.

There were performances of several amateur bands and Gainesville pops in the *Fanfares and Fireworks*. Gainesville pops played many popular marches, such as The Stars and Stripes Forever and

The Washington Post March, during the fireworks. Whereas, the traditional playing of the Boston pops on the 4th of July is 1812 overture, written by Tchaikovsky, because they play with real cannons in help from the US Army. The sound is really spectacular. Although I watched the Boston pops' performing 1812 overture several times in Korea, I have never known that it was to celebrate the 4th of July.

Comparing the scale of orchestra, its quality of performance, and size of gathering people in Gainesville and Boston is meaningless because physical magnitudes of both cities are hugely different. But I noticed other differences. There were significant gaps in the proportion of people wearing the national flag clothes or items, and degree of people's enthusiasm. The proportion of such people and degree of enthusiasm was absolutely higher in Boston than Gainesville. This phenomenon was also similar in 2021. Both Gainesville and Boston are university cities having many international students, and have similar political propensities, favoring the liberal party. As far as I can guess, the causes of those differences are that Massachusetts belonged to the original 13 states in the time of independence, but Florida did not, and it is hotter and more humid in Gainesville than Boston. But I'm not sure whether my guesses are right or not.

Irrespective of magnitude of visible things, the US citizens seemed to really enjoy and celebrate the Independence Day. I truly envy it. I hope that Koreans, especially our new government, congratulate and enjoy our independence with the past behind. Happy Independence Day!

Space medicine technology and its effects today

What is the origin of personalized medicine? How about the Da Vinci robot surgeon? Or telemedicine that allows people to consult with health experts remotely? People did not pay much attention to where this technology came from and its effects on our everyday lives. Since the advent of human space exploration, the technology of space medicine has contributed to astronauts' well-being. Still, it has also helped humanity here on Earth to improve health and prevent disease. Several effects of space medicine technology have helped us better understand and cure certain diseases today: drug advancement, personalized medicine, and artificial gravity.

In spite of the unique microgravity environment, space medicine technology contributes to the advancement of drugs. The process of extracting and purifying active components in the production of drugs is often influenced by the force of gravity equal to 1 on Earth. However, suppose those steps of drug production are carried out in a microgravity (weightlessness) environment. In that case, people will achieve improved results in terms of the drug's physical properties of the final product. For example, improved treatment for diabetics could be provided by space-formatted insulin with a crystal-clear view. In other words, the new forms of the hormone will reduce some of the health risks and discomfort associated with diabetes. Patients would receive fewer shots per day and maybe fewer per week, and their lifestyle would be more manageable.

Humanity has increasingly recognized the need for personalized (precise) medicine to treat many diseases, and space medicine technology has contributed significantly to the delivery of precise treatments. Today genetic profiling is used to guide decision-making regarding disease prevention, diagnosis, and treatment. Initially, this technology was developed for use in space medicine. For example, let's consider the case of space motion sickness, which is a motion sickness caused by the sensation that the astronaut's surroundings are in motion, yet there is no sense of motion in the astronaut's own body. Approximately 2/3 of astronauts experience it within the first three days in microgravity, with signs and symptoms appearing instantly. To solve this problem, scientists used an individual-based precise approach to determine the level of sensitivity for each astronaut so that the appropriate medicine and dose could be selected. This method has proven very effective, and scientists working on the ground have adopted it for the precise treatment of patients here on Earth. It is evident from this example that space medicine technology of precise individualized medicine has a profound impact on today's treatment.

In the above examples, we have seen that space medicine technologies have a profound effect on our lives, but here is one more example of how current developments of artificial (simulated) gravity will influence humans' treatment and prevention of certain diseases here on Earth. It is now possible for astronauts to live and work in space for six months. A prolonged stay in space can have a variety of effects on the body, including muscle atrophy, bone loss, immune system impairments, and endocrine disorders. However, the goal of all space agencies is to go to the Moon and Mars and stay there for a significant period of time, more than six months. Consequently, humanity must establish for humans in space (space station) a similar environment to that on Earth, which will not negatively impact their health over the long term. Artificial gravity or simulated gravity is one possible solution to this problem.

An artificial gravity system creates an inertial force within a spacecraft to replicate gravity's force. This concept is often seen in science fiction shows such as "Star Trek," and researchers are currently working on creating artificial gravity in space. Recently, scientists have discovered that this technology can also be used on Earth to treat certain dermatological conditions. Artificial gravity is an example of space medicine technology that will significantly affect our treatment methods for certain diseases in the future.

To conclude, the author will point to several effects of space medicine technology that have helped us better understand and treat certain diseases today: drug advances, personalized medicine, and artificial gravity. Firstly, due to advancements in space technology, patients will receive fewer daily doses, making their lifestyle much more manageable. Secondly, personalized medicine, which emerged from space technology, has and will significantly alter the future prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of diseases. Lastly, artificial gravity technology will open a window of opportunity to treat certain pathological conditions. Throughout history, space medicine technology has dramatically affected our medicine and will have a lasting impact on the health of humans in the future.
